Commission Chair Erin Saberi called the meeting to order at 6:05pm. Quorum was established.

Small introduction from Nations Finest (used to be called Veteran's Resource Center), Val (Assistant Site Director) focuses on unhoused veterans for men and women. Helps with rapid rehousing and homeless prevention. Provides some help with move in costs. One grant is Grant Per Diem (GPD) – predominantly male has to have history of mental health or substance use. Helps with employment, income, medical, substance use, education. Program for women – offsite location for female identifying and children and females escaping domestic violence. Case management services are provided at the women's home or at this facility. For veterans that have VA services, they connect to the VA and if not, they link them to coverage. They can be housed for a year, used to be 2 years. For more information, Nationsfinest.com
