## **Sacramento County Commission on the Status of Women and Girls 2023–2025 Work Plan Objectives**

### **Objective 1 – "How Are the Women and Girls?" Data Project**

The Commission will work with Sacramento State Institute on Social Research (ISSR) to establish and track data indicators about the status of women and girls in Sacramento County and communicate the data story to the Board of Supervisors and the public.

This will include a landscape review of the homeless and domestic violence beds available for women and girls countywide.

### **Objective 2 – Sacramento Women and Girls Resource Hub**

The Commission will develop an interactive resource hub that links women and girls and the organizations that serve women and girls, to services, volunteers and activities.

### **Objective 3 – Sacramento County Budget**

The Commission will review the county annual budget and make recommendations to the Board of Supervisors on budget items concerning women and girls.

### **Objective 4 – Issue Priorities**

#### **4.1 Housing and Homelessness**

Prevention of homelessness, particularly for older women  
Homeless Point In Time (PIT) count support

#### **4.2 Childcare**

Participant partner in the new Sacramento County Child Care Coalition with support through the CCSWG grant to develop a county Childcare FAQ (meetings

#### **4.3 Domestic Violence**

Participant partner in the Sacramento County Domestic Violence Council (meetings first Friday of the month)

#### **4.4 Economic Security**

Childcare work as listed above.

Establish communications tools and presence for the Commission and Friends to engage and support a wide audience of Sacramento County women, girls, stakeholders, cities within the County, and public: Website, social media, materials, events, community listening circles.
